 - In the evening, visit the famous **Sanganeri Printing Showroom**, where you can witness the traditional hand-block printing technique and shop for authentic Rajasthani textiles and handicrafts.

 - Later, visit the historic Mandawa Fort, which reflects the royal legacy and architectural brilliance of the region.

- Upon arrival in Bikaner, visit the magnificent **Junagarh Fort**, one of Rajasthan's finest forts, renowned for its grand palaces and impressive Rajput architecture.
- Explore its magnificent sections, including **Anup Mahal**, **Gaj Mandir**, **Sheesh Mahal**, and the **Archaeological Museum**, each showcasing the city's rich royal heritage.

- Later, proceed to the enchanting **Sam Sand Dunes**. Enjoy an unforgettable **camel safari across the golden desert** while witnessing a breathtaking sunset.
- In the evening, experience the vibrant culture of Rajasthan through traditional folk music and dance performances under the starlit desert sky.

- Upon arrival in Jodhpur, spend the evening exploring the bustling **Ghanta Ghar** (Clock Tower) and the vibrant **Sardar Market**, where you can shop for handicrafts, textiles, spices, antiques, and traditional Rajasthani souvenirs.

- Later, visit the elegant **Jaswant Thada**, a beautiful white marble cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. Continue to the magnificent **Umaid Bhawan** Palace, one of the world's largest private residences and an outstanding example of Indo-Deco architecture.
- Afterwards, proceed to Jodhpur Railway Station or Jodhpur Airport for your onward journey, carrying unforgettable memories of Rajasthan's majestic forts, royal palaces, golden deserts, and vibrant traditions.
