- **Gorakhnath Temple:** A revered Hindu temple dedicated to Guru Gorakhnath and an important spiritual landmark in Gorakhpur.

🕒 Day 1

Gorakhpur – Bhairahawa – Lumbini

📍 Lumbini

- Arrive at Gorakhpur Railway Station, where our Tour Manager will warmly welcome you and assist with the journey.
- Proceed to the Sonauli Border and complete the immigration formalities before entering Nepal. Continue to Bhairahawa and check in to the hotel.
- In the evening, visit Lumbini, the sacred birthplace of Lord Gautam Buddha and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the peaceful **Maya Devi Temple**, the **sacred garden**, and the **Ashoka Pillar**, making it a spiritually enriching experience.

📍 Pokhara

- Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and spend the evening exploring the lively Lakeside Market, where you can shop for local handicrafts, souvenirs, and traditional Nepali products.

 - In the evening, enjoy a peaceful boat ride on the serene **Phewa Lake** while admiring the breathtaking reflection of Mt. Machhapuchhre (Fishtail Peak). Visit the **Tal Barahi Temple**, beautifully situated on an island in the middle of the lake.
 - The evening is free for shopping and leisure.

- After seeking the blessings of Goddess Manakamana, continue your scenic journey to Kathmandu and check in to the hotel.

 - Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

- Guests opting for Joining & Leaving arrangements are required to book their own flight/train tickets and arrange airport/railway station transfers unless otherwise specified.

- Your arrival airport must be the same as the group's scheduled arrival airport.
- Your arrival time should be at least one hour before the scheduled group flight arrival time.
- On the last day, your departure flight must be from the same airport and scheduled after the group's departure flight.
