- Later, enjoy a **Rajasthani folk dance performance**.

 - Upon arrival in Jodhpur, in the evening visit the famous **Ghanta Ghar (Clock Tower)** and **Sardar Market** for shopping and exploration.

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- Today, visit the famous **Mehrangarh Fort**, one of the largest forts in India.

 - Later, visit **Jaswant Thada**, a royal cenotaph built in white marble.
 - Also, visit the magnificent Umaid Bhawan Palace, built by Maharaja Umaid Singh in the 20th century.
 - Later, proceed to Jodhpur Railway Station for your onward journey.
